SCHOOL LUNCHES

A student must bring lunch each full day of school unless a hot lunch was ordered in advance. **Monday, August 16th will be the first day with hot lunch.** Ordering will begin on August 1st at joycatering.ahotlunch.com. Every family who wants to order hot lunch will need to add each child and enter them into the appropriate grade level.

Daily hot lunch prices:

K=\$3.97, 1st-4th=\$4.22, 5th-6th=\$4.47.

Portions increase at the noted grade levels.

Emergency lunches will be available for \$6 (\$5 if paid within 24 hours.) An emergency lunch consists of: a microwave lunch entree, fruit, and a cookie. If you would like to bring your student a special lunch, it must be in the office BEFORE the beginning of lunch time; otherwise an Emergency Lunch will be given to them.

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE

We offer Before School Care (BSC) and After School Care (ASC) for students in grades K-6.

BSC begins Monday, August 16th. Care will NOT be available August 12th or 13th.

Hours: 7:30-7:55am each school day

Cost: \$2/child/day or \$120/child/semester

BSC will be available on Fog Delay days, even though school will start at 10:30am.

ASC begins Monday, August 16th. Care will NOT be available August 12th or 13th.

Hours: 3:00-5:30pm following full school days

Cost: \$8/child/day or \$500/child/semester

Fees will be charged for late pick-up.

Online Registration: After class lists are emailed, another email with a BASC registration how-to will be sent. New registration is required for each student every year.

Billing: Billing will be monthly for daily rate users and automated through the parent's Family Portal account. Semester rates will be due September 1st and February 1st.

Later in July, a more detailed BASC informational sheet will be emailed to all families who were new to CVC last year or will be new this year to ensure they're fully informed!

FINANCE INFORMATION

Payments for Tuition and Incidental Expenses (Child Care, Milk, Continuous Enrollment Fees, Class Dues, etc.) can be made online through your Family Portal or through the CavFacts app.

Tuition payments are due the 1st of each month. A 10-day grace period will be allowed before a late fee of 1.5% of the balance owed is assessed. FACTS will send a reminder email by the 15th of each month, prior to the payment date.

Any parent who withdraws their student during the school year, will be charged tuition to the completion of the quarter in which the student is withdrawn. This policy will apply to all situations except those in which the withdrawal is due to a move out of the area or in which your child(ren) has been asked by the School Board to leave the school.

It is important that a family notify our Enrollment Coordinator, Nicole Mulder (nmulder@cvc.org) if they do not plan to have their child(ren) return.
